Mayor Marvin called the public hearing to order at 8:06 p.m. She stated that the purpose of the public hearing was to take public comment on the following proposed changes to the Code of the Village of Bronxville, Chapter 290, Vehicles and Traffic:

CODE AMENDMENT RESOLUTION #1 - 2006

**§ A321-5. Chapter 290, Vehicles and Traffic**

Amend "D. Section 290-47, Parking Permits", Subsections (3) (a) and (3) (e) to read as follows:

- (3) Off-street public parking lot parking permit:
  - (a) Colodny Lot: \$80 per month.
  - (e) Stone Place Tandem Parking Area: \$80 per month single space;  
\$40 per month each tandem space.

Mayor Marvin explained that we found in reviewing our records that all our public lots were \$80 per month except the Colodny Lot and Stone Place Tandem Parking Area. The fee for these lots was \$60 per month. She said that we are just trying to put some uniformity in our parking rates throughout the Village.

Richard Magat, Westbourne Apartments, asked where the Colodny Lot was.

Parking Commissioner Murphy responded that the Colodny Lot is located behind 45 Kraft Avenue. He said the Village has 60 parking spaces in the lot. Mr. Murphy said that the Stone Place tandem spaces are on Stone Place near the paddle tennis courts and the Maltby Lot.

Mayor Marvin asked if there were any Trustee comments. There were none.

There being no further comments, the public hearing was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
