Mayor Marvin called the public hearing to order at 8:05 p.m. She stated that the purpose of the public hearing was to hear and consider comments with regard to the Village's Application for a *Community Development Block Grant*.

Village Administrator Porr explained that the public hearing was being held *to receive comments from the public in support of the Village's application to Westchester County for a grant of \$300,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds to improve handicapped accessibility at Village Hall.* **He verified that due notice of the public hearing had been given by posting and publication.**

Mr. Porr said that although Bronxville has been a member of the Community Development Block Program for many years, this is the first time we are applying for funds. We are seeking a grant to cover some of the costs associated with making Village Hall accessible to the physically challenged by constructing ramps and an elevator. He noted that in addition to serving the residents of Bronxville, Village Hall staff also serve many people of all backgrounds from outside our community by providing birth and death records, services for seniors in the greater Bronxville area, and children in our summer camp. Mr. Porr said that any comments tonight will be used to strengthen our grant application. He said after closing the hearing this evening that the Village would accept written comments and letters of support for the next thirty days.
